in Soviet espionage - General Sharapov took  
over duties of General Vasiliyev as head of the 1st  
Department of Soviet Intelligence in the US shortly  
before June 1948

3) P. I. Sharapov; Director of the All-Russian Trade  
Syndicate in New York City - Soviet controlled

Fitzgerald Curtis Smith stated Boris Yefimovich  
Belitskiy trusted to U.S. citizens in Moscow except  
(Smith) & Aline Mosby  
Mosby & Shapiro worked in same office  
Mosby knew Alexander Dolberg - introduced by  
McKinney H. Russell. Smith contacted Belitskiy  
through Irvine R. Levine.
